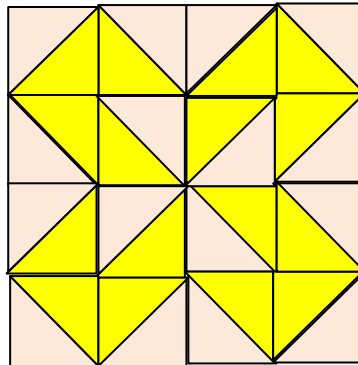


## Overall Quilter Block of the Month #2

Marc and I were married October 21<sup>st</sup> 1989. We went to Colorado for our Honeymoon. Colorado Beauty is made up of 16 half square triangles. Here's a quick and easy way to make this 2 color block.

Colorado Beauty

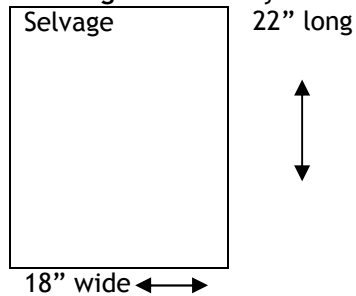


1 fat quarter each of the following

Fabric A- background- beige

Fabric B- Focus- Yellow/orange

**Cutting:** remember you are cutting from selvage to cut side on a fat quarter



Fabric A:

- Cut one 8 ¼ " strip  
Sub cut into two 8 ¼" squares

Fabric B:

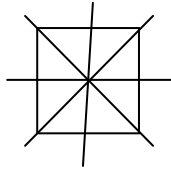
- Cut one 8 ¼ " strip  
Sub cut into two 8 ¼" squares

**Making the Half square triangle unit**

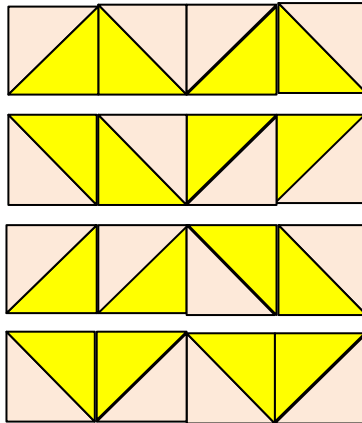
Draw two diagonal lines from corner to corner on the wrong side of the B squares.



Lay one 8 ¼" A square and one 8 ¼" B Square right sides together. Stitch ¼" on each side of the drawn lines. Cut on the drawn line and in a t yielding 8 half square triangles. Press seams open. Using a 3 ½" square ruler line up the center seam, trim to 3 ½" square as needed. Repeat for a total of 16 half square triangle units.



**Block Assembly:**



Test your ¼" seam.

Sew each block into rows. Press seams open

Sew rows together.
