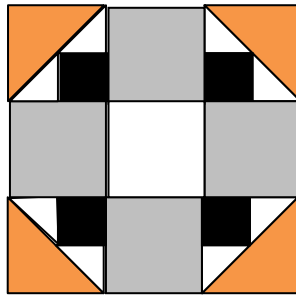


# Sweet Memories Block #3

## Album

I've tried other hobbies, like scrap booking, or is it book scrapping? Anyway I went out bought all the gadgets, but it didn't fill me like quilting has. So in memory of my scrap booking stash here is the Album block.

Album



1 fat quarter each of the following

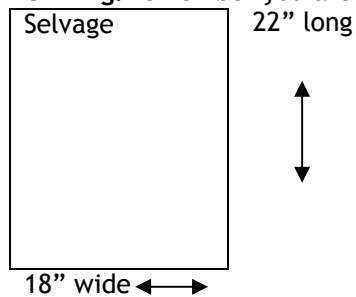
Fabric A- Center Square, triangles- beige

Fabric B- small squares- skeleton

Fabric C- Corner triangles- orange/green

Fabric D- large squares- web

**Cutting:** remember you are cutting from selvage to cut side on a fat quarter



Fabric A:

- Cut one 2 1/2" strip  
Sub cut into four 2 1/2"x4" rectangles  
Cut one 4 1/2" square

Fabric B:

- Cut one 2 1/2" strip  
Sub cut into four 2 1/2" squares

Fabric C:

- Cut one 4 3/4" strip  
Sub cut into two 4 3/4" squares  
Cut diagonal once yielding 4 triangles

Fabric D:

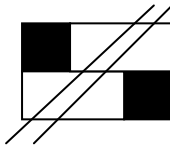
- Cut one 4 1/2" strip  
Sub cut into four 4 1/2" squares

## Before sewing, always check your 1/4" seam allowance!

### Making the pieced unit

Sew the 2 1/2" square B unit to the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" A unit  
Repeat 3 times, making 4 total.

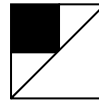
Sew two of this unit together with small squares on opposite ends



Align ruler with corners, use 1/4" marking

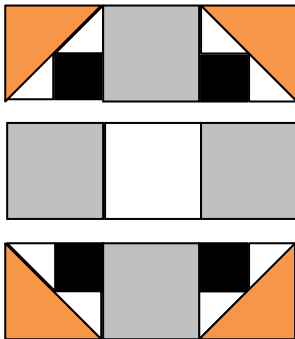
Cut unit a part diagonally twice leaving 1/4"

Sew a triangle unit C to opposite side of this unit  
necessary.



Square unit to 4 1/2" as

### Block Assembly:



Test your 1/4" seam.

Sew each block into rows. Press seams open

Sew rows together.
